Hand-drawn charts have been discovered that were created over 60 years ago. They describe communities submerged under the water's surface, parts of which were not fully demolished prior to flooding the land. These valuable maps were almost tossed out with the trash until someone quickly realized the value they had discovered.

Lake Lanier has 38,000 acres of water that makes it possible for boating and swimming as well as water to our homes and the generation of hydroelectric power.

Buford Dam on Lake Lanier was a billion-dollar project that broke ground with a spade of dirt in 1950. The project was so huge that it took the Army Corps of Engineers to make it happen.

Farms, cemeteries and even a racetrack were submerged. It was discovered in 2007 during a major drought that the grandstands of the half mile race track were still intact when they were partially uncovered by the receding waters.


The project was given to the Army Corps of Engineers for Lake Lanier in 1946. The purchase of land was not made until two years later after the end of WW II.
